

Privacy Policy for our NetSTAR (inCompass.NetSTAR-inc.com) (our “Website”) and Technology (our “Technology”)

This document explains our collection and usage practices of personally identifiable information with respect to the information gathered by our Websites and our NetSTAR Technologies. Our Technology is what is used by our NetSTAR categorization engines, malicious detection systems and other tools and utilities that we utilize to process URL queries and content submissions in order to provide access to and/or generate data sets.

Collection and Use of Information

NetSTAR does not intentionally collect personally identifiable information (e.g., postal address, email address, telephone number) about an individual unless you choose to provide it to us through an online form, through e-mail, or you are accessing client-specific secure content through our NetSTAR Technology as a client or prospective client.

NetSTAR generally only collects personally identifiable information from clients and prospective clients and requires that they use NetSTAR-issued License Credentials in order to use and access NetSTAR Technology and Services.

We will use personally identifiable information from our clients or prospective clients in order to create and maintain billing and other business records and for other legitimate purposes and will generally store this information so long as we maintain a business relationship with our client and for a reasonable time after the termination of the business relationship.

We do not intentionally collect personally identifiable information through our Technology.

Our website may collect non-personally identifiable information. For example, our website automatically create logs on the queries you make, the content you submit and the data sets you access, obtain, and/or generate when using a NetSTAR website or server. We generally use this information in statistical and aggregate formats to assess the effectiveness of our offerings as well as to make them better and easier to use.

We do collect and store a wide range of data sets on the attributes of URLs and unstructured content that is queried or submitted for processing. We use this information to enable our Technology to provide NetSTAR Services to our customers, and we may share this information with our customers for use within their applications.

Use of Cookies

In some cases, we utilize cookies to enhance the performance and effectiveness of our Technology and NetSTAR Services. If you do not want us to place a cookie on your hard drive, you may be able to turn that feature off on your computer. Please consult your Internet browser's documentation for information on how to do this and how to delete cookies. However, if you decide not to accept cookies from us, some of our Technology may not function properly.

Additional Privacy Information Applicable to all NetSTAR Websites and Services Data Security/Integrity

We take commercially reasonable security measures to protect the information in our care from loss, misuse, alteration or destruction. However, no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure; therefore, we cannot guarantee absolute security.

Children's Privacy

If we discover that a child under the age of 13 has supplied personally identifiable information to us without his/her parent's consent, we will use reasonable attempts to ensure that this information is deleted from our system.

Disclosure of Information by NetSTAR

As mentioned above, we use the information collected by our Technology in order to provide our NetSTAR Services to our customers, and we may share this information with our customers as part of our offerings.

We may also use and/or share such information as described below:

- We may employ other companies and individuals to perform functions on our behalf. Examples may include providing technical assistance and hosting services. These other companies will have access to such information only as necessary to perform their functions and to the extent permitted by law.
- In an ongoing effort to better understand our products and services, we may analyze such information in aggregate form in order to operate, maintain, manage, and improve our products and services. This aggregate information does not identify you personally. We may share this aggregate data with our affiliates, agents, and business partners. We may also disclose aggregated user statistics in order to describe our products and services to current and

prospective business partners and to other third parties for other lawful purposes.

- We may share some or all of such information with any of our subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other companies under common control with us.
- As we develop our business and services, we might sell or buy businesses or assets. In the event of a corporate sale, merger, reorganization, sale of assets, dissolution, or similar event, such information may be part of the transferred assets.
- To the extent permitted by law, we may also disclose such information: (i) when required by law, court order, or other government or law enforcement authority or regulatory agency; or (ii) whenever we believe that disclosing such information is necessary or advisable, for example, to protect the rights, property, or safety of us or others.
